20	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that a new House
21	Rule 11-24-6 be enacted to read:
22	"11-24-6 When a bill passed by the house and returned by the
23	senate for concurrence contains an emergency clause,
24	an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the
25	members present is required for concurrence.".
