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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. Section 9-29A-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2020,
19	Chapter 3, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
20	"9-29A-1. EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CARE FUND
21	A. The "early childhood education and care fund" is
22	created within the state treasury. The fund shall consist of
23	distributions, appropriations, gifts, grants and donations.
24	Income from investment of the fund shall be credited to the
25	fund. Money in the fund shall be expended only as provided in

2 Β. The state investment officer, subject to the 3 approval of the state investment council, shall invest money in 4 the early childhood education and care fund: 5 in accordance with the prudent investor (1)6 rule set forth in the Uniform Prudent Investor Act; and 7 in consultation with the state treasurer. (2)The state investment officer shall report C. 8 9 quarterly to the legislative finance committee and the state 10 investment council on the investments made pursuant to this 11 section. Annually, a report shall be submitted no later than 12 October 1 each year to the legislative finance committee, the 13 revenue stabilization and tax policy committee and any other 14 appropriate interim committees. 15 On July 1 of each year, a distribution shall be D. 16 made from the early childhood education and care fund to the 17 early childhood education and care program fund in an amount 18 equal to the greater of five percent of the average of the 19 year-end market values of the fund for the immediately 20 preceding three calendar years or [one hundred fifty million 21 dollars (\$150,000,000)] two hundred fifty million dollars 22 (\$25<u>0,000,000)</u>.

E. In addition to the distribution pursuant to Subsection D of this section, money in the early childhood education and care fund may be expended in the event that .226773.2

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23 24 25 general fund balances, including all authorized revenues and transfers to the general fund and balances in the general fund operating reserve, the appropriation contingency fund, the tobacco settlement permanent fund, the state-support reserve fund and the tax stabilization reserve, will not meet the level of appropriations authorized from the general fund for a fiscal year. In that event, to avoid an unconstitutional deficit, the legislature may appropriate from the early childhood education and care fund to the general fund only in the amount necessary to meet general fund appropriations for that fiscal year and only if the legislature has authorized transfers from the appropriation contingency fund, the general fund operating reserve, the tax stabilization reserve and the tobacco settlement permanent fund that exhaust those fund balances."

SECTION 2. Section 9-29A-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2020, Chapter 3, Section 2) is amended to read:

"9-29A-2. EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CARE PROGRAM FUND.--The "early childhood education and care program fund" is created [as a nonreverting fund] in the state treasury. The fund consists of distributions, appropriations, gifts, grants, donations and income from investment of the fund. The early childhood education and care department shall administer the fund. Money in the fund is subject to appropriation by the legislature for early childhood education and care services and programs. Expenditures from the fund shall be by warrant of
