5	WHEREAS, Valencia county is part of the Rio Abajo; and	
6	WHEREAS, Valencia county is the home of the largest	
7	matanza in the world, and the matanza is a symbol of the rich	
8	Spanish heritage of the Rio Grande valley; and	
9	WHEREAS, the matanza is a family fun event hosted by the	
10	Hispano chamber of Valencia county to raise funds to provide	
11	scholarships to students while preserving Valencia county	
12	traditions by promoting and enhancing local business	
13	development through civic, social, cultural and employment	
14	training programs; and	
15	WHEREAS, Valencia county is the home of the famous Tome	
16	land grant, which the king of Spain granted to thirty	
17	families in 1739; and	
18	WHEREAS, the village of Los Lunas was founded by	
19	Spaniards in the seventeenth century; and	
20	WHEREAS, the village of Los Lunas has been identified as	
21	New Mexico's second-fastest growing community, with expansive	
22	population growth; and	
23	WHEREAS, the population growth of the village of Los	
24	Lunas holds a significant role in New Mexico's expanding and	
25	competitive economic landscape and is a catalyst for major	HM 35 Page l

1 industrial manufacturing, technological and economic development in Valencia county; and 2 3 WHEREAS, Belen is officially known as "Nuestra Señora de 4 Belen", or "Our Lady of Belen"; and 5 WHEREAS, Belen means "Bethlehem" in Spanish; and WHEREAS, Belen was a strategic point along the Camino 6 Real, also known as the "Royal Road", which carved a trade 7 route south into Mexico; and 8 WHEREAS, Belen has gained the nickname "hub city" 9 10 because of the Belen cutoff of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe railway, now known as the BNSF railway company; and 11 WHEREAS, the original pre-1937 United States route 66 12 runs through the heart of Valencia county; and 13 WHEREAS, Bosque Farms was a destination for relocated 14 15 dust bowl refugees; and 16 WHEREAS, Bosque Farms strives to be a sparsely populated, agricultural community; and 17 WHEREAS, Peralta was the site of a minor engagement 18 during the American civil war; and 19 WHEREAS, Rio Communities is home to Valencia county's 20 only golf course, Tierra del Sol; and 21 WHEREAS, Valencia county is home to the decalogue stone, 22 which contains an inscription that is interpreted to be an 23 abridged version of the ten commandments in a form of the 24 Paleo-Hebrew alphabet; and 25
